AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE OPERATION OF MINIBIKES IN THE CITY OF OBERLIN.

DATED:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, the majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: Definitions.

A minibike is herewith defined as a bicycle driven by an internal combustion or power type engine or devise other than the operation by the operator under the operator's physical power.

A bicycle is defined as a 2 or 3 wheel vehicle capable of operating over the surfaces of the streets or public places.

SECTION 2: From and after the effective date of this Ordinance it shall be unlawful to operate a minibike over or upon the streets or public places of the City of Oberlin.

SECTION 3: A violator of the Section, upon conviction, shall be fined not less that \$10.00 nor more than \$50.00, and costs.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
