## ORDINANCE NO. 860

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A COST OF LIVING PAY INCREASE FOR ALL FULL TIME EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. There is herewith granted, effective the 1st day of April, 1972, a Three per cent (3%) cost of living pay increase for all full time city employees of the City of Oberlin.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"To compensate and so retain City Employees in the service of the City of Oberlin, and shall take effect immediately upon passage"
