

ORDINANCE NO. 869 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING BIDS FOR OIL FILLED
TRANSFORMER AND FUSE INTERRUPTER SWITCH GEAR
AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain
County, Ohio, Five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto
concurring:

SECTION 1. That the following bids, being the lowest and
best bids for oil filled transformer and fuse interrupter switch
gear, are hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized
to enter into contracts accordingly, the bids being:

OIL FILLED TRANSFORMER - Controlled Power Corporation
\$9,900.00


FUSE INTERRUPTER SWITCH GEAR - S. & C. Electric Co.
Alternate bid A - \$13,280.00

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin,
Ohio, to wit:

"To expedite construction of the College library substation"
and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
