

ORDINANCE NO. 875 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING A BID AND AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN ASPHALTIC CONCRETE SURFACE ON PYLE-SOUTH AMHERST ROAD FROM WEST LORAIN STREET TO MORGAN STREET AND FROM SOUTH MAIN STREET EASTERLY TO CITY LIMITS ON EAST HAMILTON STREET IN THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin has received bids for paving a portion of Pyle-South Amherst Road and East Hamilton Street;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Plas Construction Corporation for the paving of Pyle-South Amherst Road from Lorain Street to Morgan Street and from South Main Street Easterly to City Limits on East Hamilton Street, in the amount of Eighteen Thousand Seven and 00/100 Dollars (\$18,007.00) with a completion time of Sixty (60) days, being the lowest and best bid, is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby directed to execute a contract accordingly.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"To safeguard traffic in the City of Oberlin and shall take effect immediately upon passage."
