ORDINANCE NO. 876 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING A BID AND AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR SEEDING AND MULCHING OF THE EAST BERM OF STATE ROUTE #58 FROM HAMILTON STREET TO THE LORAIN COUNTY JOINT VOCATIONAL SCHOOL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The City of Oberlin, Ohio, has heretofore installed a sanitary sewer line from the City limits of the City of Oberlin, South to the Lorain County Joint Vocational School, and

WHEREAS, seeding and mulching of the East berm of State Route #58 is determined necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Bid of Scalaro & Sons, Inc., being the lowest and best bid for said seeding and mulching in accordance with Ohio Department of Highways Specification 659, in the total amount of Two Thousand One Hundred Seventy Eight and 00/100 Dollars (\$2,178.00) is hereby accepted and the City Manager authorized to enter into a contract accordingly.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"In order to complete the project of installing a sanitary sewer line and shall take effect immediately upon passage."
