## ORDINANCE NO. 877 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING BIDS FOR FUEL OIL SPECIFICATIONS 1 AND 2 AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the following bids being the lowest and best bids for Fuel Oil are hereby accepted and the City Manager authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bids being as follows:

Standard Oil Co., Specification 1 alternate bid .1143--2 day delivery 1% discount/10 days

Standard Oil Co., Specification 2 .1168--2 day delivery 1% discount/10 days

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"To provide fuel oil for the Oberlin light plant and shall take effect immediately upon passage."
