

ORDINANCE NO. 887 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF GENERAL ELECTRIC
SUPPLY FOR THE FURNISHING OF THREE TRANSFORMERS AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members
elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of General Electric Supply
being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of three
transformers be and the same is hereby accepted, and the City
Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accord-
ingly, the bid being \$13,974.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to
be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preserva-
tion of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens
of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"To supply additional power to consumers and shall
take effect immediately upon passage."
