

ORDINANCE NO. 897 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BIDS OF KUHLMAN ELECTRIC COMPANY AND GENERAL ELECTRIC SUPPLY FOR THE FURNISHING OF TRANSFORMERS AND CIRCUIT BREAKERS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Kuhlman Electric Company being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of one outdoor oil filled 3750 KVA Transformer, be and the same is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$10,970.00.


SECTION 2. That the bid of General Electric Supply Co., being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of two vacuum circuit breakers with optional additional devices, be and the same is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$11,540.00.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"To provide a higher quality service to electric power consumers and shall take effect immediately upon passage."
