

ORDINANCE NO. 901 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING BIDS FOR CHEMICALS USED IN WATER TREATMENT AND WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANT OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, FOR THE YEAR 1973, AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, Five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the following bids being the lowest and best bids for certain chemicals used by the Water Treatment Plant for water treatment and waste water treatment, for the year 1973, are hereby accepted, and the City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract accordingly,



