

ORDINANCE NO. 905 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID FOR GASOLINE
FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN FOR 1973 AND DECLARING
SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members
elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Standard Oil Company of
Ohio, being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of
gasoline for use by the City of Oberlin, Ohio, be and the same
is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized
to enter into a contract accordingly, the bids being as follows:

Gasoline, Regular --- 0.1335 per gallon
Gasoline, Premium --- 0.1535 per gallon

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to
be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preserva-
tion of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens
of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"To provide fuel for the motor vehicles of the
City of Oberlin, Ohio, and shall take effect
immediately upon passage".
