

ORDINANCE NO. 908 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A POLICE AND FIRE ALARM
MONITORING SYSTEM FRANCHISE TO DIEBOLD, INCORP-
ORATED

WHEREAS, there is presently no alarm monitoring system
in the City of Oberlin, and

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin has determined the neces-
sity for an alarm system, and

WHEREAS, Diebold, Inc., submitted the best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the
City of Oberlin County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths
(5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Diebold, Incorporated is hereby granted
an exclusive franchise for the operation of an alarm monitoring
system in the City of Oberlin.


SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of
the public peace, safety, and welfare of the citizens of
Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

To provide uninterrupted daily operations of the
Police and Fire Departments of the City of Oberlin,
Ohio,

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
