ORDINANCE NO. 909 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE KEEPING OF DOGS IN THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, TO AMEND CODIFIED ORDINANCE 511.02 AND TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICT HEREWITH

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, a majority of all members dected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. Codified Ordinance 511.02 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"No owner, keeper or harborer of a dog shall permit such dog to leave the premises of such owner, keeper or harborer, except when on a leash or in a suitable container or conveyance.

It shall be the duty of dog wardens, police officers or others having the authority of police officers to investigate all dogs running at large."

SECTION 2. That all former ordinances and parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
