ORDINANCE NO. 911 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING A FIRE CONTRACT WITH THE PITTSFIELD TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES AND DECLARING THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City of Oberlin shall, upon the effective date of this Ordinance, provide fire protection in the same manner as heretofore for certain parts of Pittsfield Township for the year 1973, for the following consideration:

\$1,000 base fee plus \$30.00 per year per fire hydrant in Pittsfield Township

SECTION 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure to provide official duty protection for the Oberlin Fire Department while in Pittsfield Township and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
