## ORDINANCE NO. 914 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID FOR A DUMP TRUCK FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN FOR 1973 AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:
