

ORDINANCE NO. 915 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID FOR REFUSE  
CONTAINERS FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN FOR  
1973 AND DECLARING THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,  
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members  
elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Sanitary Controls, Inc.,  
of Deer Park, New York, being the lowest and best bid for the  
furnishing of refuse containers for use by the City of Oberlin,  
Ohio, be and the same is hereby accepted, and the City Manager  
is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the  
bids being as follows:

1 CY, unit price \$105.00, 1-1/2 CY, Unit Price  
\$110.00

2 CY, unit price \$150.00

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared  
to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preserva-  
tion of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of  
the City of Oberlin, Ohio.
