

ORDINANCE NO. 916 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID FOR CONSTRUCTION  
OF WILLOWBROOK DRAINAGE DITCH FOR THE CITY OF  
OBERLIN FOR 1973 AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,  
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members  
elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Palkovic Excavating Service of Oberlin, Ohio, being the lowest and best bid for the construction of Willowbrook Drainage Ditch for the City of Oberlin, Ohio, be and the same is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being as follows:

Six months to complete at a cost of \$2,155.00

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio.
