

ORDINANCE NO. 918 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF THE ORDINARY EXPENSES OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN UNTIL SUCH TIME AS THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS MEASURE SHALL BE PASSED AND DECLARE THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the official certificate of estimated resources has not been received from the County Budget Commission, and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds on hand to operate until such time as the official certificate is received.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, Lorain County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Auditor be authorized to pay all ordinary bills and salaries of the City.

SECTION 2. That any payment above authorized shall be chargeable to the appropriations in the annual appropriations measure when passed.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

To expedite payment of the ordinary expenses and salaries of the City of Oberlin,

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
