

ORDINANCE NO. 922 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 507 AC CMS
IMPOSING AN INCOME TAX

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members
elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. Section 16, Paragraph 6, of Ordinance No.
507 AC CMS is hereby amended to read as follows:


"6. Gains from involuntary conversions,
cancellation of indebtedness, items of
income already taxed by the State of Ohio
from which the City is specifically pro-
hibited from taxing and income of a dece-
dants estate during the period of admini-
stration (except such income from the
operation of a business)."

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of
the public peace, safety and welfare of the City of Oberlin,
Ohio, to-wit:


To comply with the existing Ohio State Income
Tax law, and shall take effect immediately upon
passage.
