

ORDINANCE NO. 923 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BIDS OF JACKSON-BAYLEY ELECTRIC COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF POWERHOUSE SUBSTATION FRAMEWORK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Jackson-Bayley Electric Company being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of substation framework, be and the same is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$7,996.00.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"To provide a higher quality service to electric power consumers and shall take effect immediately upon passage."
