

ORDINANCE NO. 924 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BIDS OF S.&C. ELECTRIC COMPANY AND R.T.E. CORPORATION FOR THE FURNISHING OF TRANSFORMERS AND SWITCHGEAR FOR THE COLLEGE AREA SUBSTATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bids of S. & C. Electric Company being the lowest and best bids for the furnishing of switchgear equipment, be and the same is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bids totalling \$23,665.00.


SECTION 2. That the bid of R.T.E. Corporation being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of one outdoor oil filled 2500 KVA Transformer, be and the same is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$8,840.00.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the publicpeace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"To provide a higher quality service to electric power consumers and shall take effect immediately upon passage."
