

ORDINANCE NO. 930 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF HENDRIX WIRE
AND CABLE CORPORATION FOR THE FURNISHING OF 500
AERIAL CABLE SPACERS 15 KV AND DECLARING SAME AN
EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members
elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1. That the bid of Hendrix Wire and Cable
Corporation being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of
500 aerial cable spacers, be and the same is hereby accepted,
and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a con-
tract accordingly, the bid being \$15,650.00.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to
be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation
of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the
City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"To provide a higher quality service to electric
power consumers and shall take effect immediately
upon passage."
