

ORDINANCE NO. 931 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE POSITION OF
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT COORDINATOR OF THE
CITY OF OBERLIN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, deems it necessary for the efficient operation of the City of Oberlin to provide for a Community Development Coordinator;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, a five-seventh (5/7th) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That there is herewith established the additional position of Community Development Coordinator with the duties as assigned by the City Manager.


SECTION 2. Said position shall be filled by appointment by the City Manager, and shall be at the pleasure of said City Manager.

SECTION 3. Said position shall carry the classification of Community Development Coordinator with the Grade 24, and the pay provision in accordance with said grade.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is hereby determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio.
