

ORDINANCE NO. 933 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER  
OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, TO ENTER INTO  
A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF A USED TRUCK

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,  
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members  
elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized  
to enter into a contract with Hayden Transport Tank, Inc.,  
Bowling Green, Ohio, for the purchase of a used 1968 Ford Truck,  
F-850, 535 cu. in. engine, tandem rear axle.

SECTION 2. That the amount said City Manager shall  
bid for said truck at an auction open to the public or at a sale  
upon invitation to the public to submit written bids, shall not  
exceed \$2,800.00.

SECTION 3. That funds for the purchase of said truck  
have previously been appropriated and remain unencumbered for  
such purpose.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to  
be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation  
of the public peace safety and welfare of the City of Oberlin,  
Ohio, to wit:

"To provide necessary equipment for the fire  
department", and shall take effect immediately  
upon passage.
