

ORDINANCE NO. 935 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID FOR TWO
POLICE CRUISERS FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN
FOR 1973 AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members
elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1. That the bid of Rowe Motors Incorporated
of Oberlin, Ohio, being the lowest and best bid for the fur-
nishing of the two Police Cruisers for use by the City of
Oberlin, Ohio, be and the same is hereby accepted, and the
City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract
accordingly, the bid being as follows:

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to
be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preserva-
tion of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens
of the City of Oberlin, Ohio.
