

ORDINANCE NO. 940 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF OHIO PUMP
COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF A LIFT STATION PUMPING SYSTEM
AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members
elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1. That the bid of Ohio Pump Company being
the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of a Lift Station
Pumping System, be and the same is hereby accepted, and the
City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract
accordingly, the bid being \$3,088.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be
an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of
public peace safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of
Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"To provide a higher quality service to water
consumers and shall take effect immediately
upon passage."
