ORDINANCE NO. 941 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE MONIES FOR AN ECONOMIC FEASIBILITY AND SPACE UTILIZATION STUDY OF WESTERVELT HALL AS A NEW CITY HALL AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to employ the services of the firm Visnapuu & Gaede Architects and Planners for the purpose of studying the economic feasibility and space factor of Westervelt Hall as a site for a new City Hall.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, in order to carry out Section 1 of this Ordinance, is authorized to expend a sum of money not to exceed \$3,000.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the City of Oberlin, Ohio.
