

ORDINANCE NO. 941 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE MONIES FOR AN
ECONOMIC FEASIBILITY AND SPACE UTILIZATION
STUDY OF WESTERVELT HALL AS A NEW CITY HALL
AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members
elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to
employ the services of the firm Visnapuu & Gaede Architects
and Planners for the purpose of studying the economic feasibility
and space factor of Westervelt Hall as a site for a new
City Hall.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, in order to carry out
Section 1 of this Ordinance, is authorized to expend a sum of
money not to exceed \$3,000.


SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to
