

ORDINANCE NO. 952 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF HART
CONSTRUCTION CO. FOR THE SEAL COATING OF
CERTAIN STREETS AND DECLARING SAME AN
EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the following bid being the lowest and the best bid for the seal coating of certain streets is hereby accepted and the City Manager authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being as follows:
