

ORDINANCE NO. 957 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY AUDITOR TO BID
ON REAL ESTATE FOR PURCHASE AT PUBLIC SALE, AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected
thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Auditor be and is hereby author-
ized to bid on behalf of the City of Oberlin a sum not to exceed
Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000.00) at public sale to be conducted
on July 6, 1973 at 9:40 A.M., Lorain County Courthouse, Elyria, for
purchase of eight (8) parcels of real estate now or formerly owned by
O'Dell Geiger et al. located in Russia and Pittsfield Townships, Lorain
County, Ohio, and being more particularly described by permanent parcel
numbers as follows:



SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the peace, safety
