

ORDINANCE NO. 969 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF ERIE PIPELINE
COMPANY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF FOUR MANHOLES AND
DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY


BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members
elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Erie Pipeline Company being
the lowest and best bid for the construction of four manholes ,
be and the same is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is here-
by authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being
\$2,070.00.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be
an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of
public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of
Oberlin, Ohio.
