

ORDINANCE NO. 972 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF BAY CONSTRUCTION INCORPORATED UPON THE ENDORSEMENT OF THE FEDERAL ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR THE EXPANSION OF THE OBERLIN WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANT AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1. That the bid of Bay Construction Incorporated, being the lowest and best bid for the expansion of the Waste Water Treatment Plant, be and the same is hereby accepted contingent upon the endorsement of the Federal E.P.A., and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$1,643,765.00.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"To provide a higher quality waste water treatment service and shall take effect immediately upon passage."
