

ORDINANCE NO. 979 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID FOR A DERRICK  
UNIT AND TRUCK CHASSIS FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN  
FOR 1973 AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY


BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of the Holan Company of Elyria, Ohio, being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of the Derrick Unit and Truck Chassis for use by the City of Oberlin, Ohio, be and the same is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$33,021.05.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio.
