

ORDINANCE NO. 1006 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY SOLICITOR
TO PROVIDE LEGAL REPRESENTATION FOR THE CITY
OF OBERLIN AND ITS OFFICERS AND COMMISSIONS
NAMED IN A TAXPAYERS SUIT FILED BY JAMES V.
MUZZY, ET AL., AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members
elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. The City Solicitor is hereby authorized
and directed to provide legal representation for the City of
Oberlin, its officers and commissions names as defendants in a
taxpayers suit filed on January 17, 1974 by James V. Muzzy, et
al.


SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of
the public peace safety and welfare to-wit:

"To provide legal representation in a pending
taxpayers suit" and the same shall take effect
immediately upon passage.
