

ORDINANCE NO. 1018 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF HENDRIX WIRE  
AND CABLE FOR PRIMARY URD CABLE AND DECLARING  
SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin,  
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected  
thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Hendrix Wire and Cable being  
the best and lowest bid for 6000' of URD Cable is hereby accepted and  
the City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract accordingly,  
said bid being:


SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency

to the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, and shall take effect  
immediately upon passage."
