## ORDINANCE NO. 1018 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF HENDRIX WIRE AND CABLE FOR PRIMARY URD CABLE AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:
