## ORDINANCE NO. 1022 AC CMS

## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A L8500 SERIES COMPUTER FROM THE BURROUGHS COMPANY

WHEREAS, the Finance Department, City of Oberlin, Ohio, is in need of a new computer that has faster printing and calculating capabilities; and

WHEREAS, the Burroughs Company manufacturers a L8500 series computer which is completely compatible with existing office equipment of the Finance Department; and

WHEREAS, if said computer is not purchased immediately, the Finance Department will be unable to process its paperwork, which will have a detrimental effect on the City.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION I. That the purchase of a L8500 Series Computer and the trade-in of the existing computer from Burroughs Company for the sum of \$9,750.82 is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"To provide necessary operating equipment for the Department of Finance, and shall take effect immediately upon passage."
