

ORDINANCE NO. 1034 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF HARRISON FORD
SALES FOR THE FURNISHING OF THREE TRUCKS FOR THE
CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain
County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto
concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Harrison Ford Sales for three

accepted, said bid being:

1974 Ford F100 Styleside	\$3,048.00	\$9,144.00


SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to
