## ORDINANCE NO. 1035 AC CMS

## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE OBERLIN PUBLIC LIBRARY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin has the authority by virtue of Section 3375.42 O.R.C. to provide financial assistance to the Library within the City of Oberlin; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Oberlin deems it necessary to enter into a contract with the Public Library to provide financial assistance for the same.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Operlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION I. That the City Manager be, and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Public Library, whereby the City will provide financial assistance to the said Library in an amount not to exceed \$15,100 as previously appropriated for and during the year 1974, to be used for Library service to the inhabitants of the taxing district of the City of Oberlin for the year 1974.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, to-wit:

"To provide immediate operating funds necessary to continue the educational services being provided by the Oberlin Public Library, and shall:take effect immediately upon passage."
