

ORDINANCE NO. 1036 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF GRAYBAR ELECTRIC COMPANY, INC., FOR THE FURNISHING OF 52 DISTRIBUTION TRANSFORMERS AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1. That the bid of Graybar Electric Company, Inc., being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of 52 Distribution Transformers be and the same is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$16,046.60.


