

ORDINANCE NO. 1042 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF PLAS  
CONSTRUCTION CORPORATION FOR STREET RE-  
SURFACING FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND  
DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of  
Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all  
members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Plas Construction  
Corporation being the lowest and best bid for the street  
resurfacing in the City of Oberlin, Ohio, be and the same  
is hereby accpeted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized  
to enter into a contract accordingly; the bid being as follows:
