

ORDINANCE NO. 1051 ACCMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF PLAS
CONSTRUCTION FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION AND
WIDENING OF SOUTH PLEASANT STREET AND
DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain
County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members
elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Plas Construction being
the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of the reconstruc-
tion and widening of South Pleasant Street, be and the same is
hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized to
enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$66,867.25.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared
to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate pre-
servation of the public peace, property and welfare of the
citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"To provide for vehicular traffic in the
City of Oberlin and shall take effect
immediately upon passage".
