ORDINANCE NO. 1053 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF OBERLIN TO CONTRACT FOR ELECTRIC INSPECTION SERVICES AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City of Oberlin to inspect all electrical improvements made in accordance with City's Electric Code, and

WHEREAS, the City does not currently have on its payroll an Electrician licensed by the State of Ohio to perform said necessary inspections.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Code Administrator of the City Of Oberlin is authorized to contract for electric improvement inspection services until such time as the City shall have on its full-time staff a qualified and licensed electric inspector.

SECTION 2. That the rate of pay for the contract services identified in Section 1 above is \$10 per inspection.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, OHIO, to-wit:

"To guarantee no disruption in the enforcement of the City Electrical Code in the City of Oberlin and shall take effect immediately upon passage."
