ORDINANCE NO. 1076 ACCMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF PLUMB CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF WATER DISTRIBUTION IMPROVEMENTS AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Plumb Construction Company, being the lowest and best bid for the construction of Water Distribution Improvements, be and same is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$31,934.80.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"To provide Water Distribution Improvements in the City of Oberlin and shall take effect immediately upon passge".
