AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE LEGAL AND
INCIDENTAL EXPENSES IN CONNECTION WITH
A LAWSUIT BROUGHT AGAINST THE CITY OF
OBERLIN

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council
of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, a majority of all members
elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1. That the City Solicitor be and he is
hereby authorized to represent the City of Oberlin in a case
brought by James Price in the Lorain County Common Pleas
Court at City expense, and to have conducted any investigation
or other work the City Solicitor deems necessary in the defense
of said suit.

effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
