AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE CONTRACT FOR PRISONER CARE WITH THE CITY OF TOLEDO, AND DECLARING SAME AN EMER-GENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. The proposed contract between the City of Oberlin and the City of Toledo for prisoner care is herewith approved.

- a. Per day rate \$10.00 plus other than ordinary medical expenses.
- b. 30 day cancellation clause by either party.

SECTION 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute said contract on behalf of the City of Oberlin.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"To provide for detention" and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
