

ORDINANCE NO. 1136 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF K.B. CONSTRUCTION  
COMPANY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SERVICE GARAGE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, Lorain  
County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected there-  
to concurring:

a six bay service garage is hereby accepted and the City Manager authorized

TOTAL BID.....\$ 25,410.00




SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
