

ORDINANCE NO. 1162 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE RE-ESTABLISHING A PAPER PICKUP PROGRAM
WITHIN THE CITY OF OBERLIN

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That effective January 1976 the City will resume on a bi-weekly basis the curb lawn collection of paper and cardboard items.

SECTION 2. That from and after January 1976 all residents in the residential areas of the City of Oberlin shall separate newspapers and magazines from their trash, and shall dispose of same as follows:

- A. All newspapers and magazines shall be securely bundled and placed at the curbside of their property in order that they may be picked up according to a schedule promulgated by the City of Oberlin.
- B. Said newspapers and magazines shall not be placed on the curbside more than twelve (12) hours before the scheduled pickup date.


SECTION 3. That from and after January 1976 all cardboard, newspapers and magazines shall be separated from other trash and garbage by all commercial establishments, including all business and industrial establishments, nursing homes and schools. All such newspapers, magazines and cardboard shall be placed by the user at a place designated by the City.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.

PASSED: 1st reading - October 20, 1975 (Tabled until 2nd meeting in Nov.)
2nd reading - November 17, 1975 (Tabled until 1st meeting in Dec.)
3rd reading - December 1, 1975 (Tabled until 2nd meeting in Dec.)
