

ORDINANCE NO. 1169 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PUR-  
CHASE OF TWO POLICE CRUISERS FOR  
THE YEAR 1976

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin, Ohio, is in need  
of new police cruisers; and

WHEREAS, advertisements for bids were made.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council  
of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, five-  
sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the purchase of two 1976 Pontiac  
LeMans Enforcer, 4-Door Sedans, for the sum of \$9,887.86 is  
hereby approved, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to  
enter into a contract with Llewellyn Motor Company, for the  
purchase of the same.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect  
at the earliest date allowed by law.
