

ORDINANCE NO. 1171 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE RE-ESTABLISHING A PAPER PICKUP
PROGRAM WITHIN THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto
concurring:

SECTION 1. That from and after January 1976 all residents in the residential areas of the City of Oberlin shall separate newspapers and magazines from their trash, and shall dispose of them as follows:

- A. All newspapers and magazines shall be securely bundled and placed at the curbside of residential properties in order that they may be picked up bi-weekly according to a schedule promulgated by the City of Oberlin.
- B. Said newspapers and magazines shall not be placed on the curbside more than twelve (12) hours before the scheduled pickup dates.

SECTION 2. That from and after January 1976, all newspapers, magazines and other easily separated paper materials, excluding corrugated and non-corrugated cardboard, shall be separated from other trash and garbage by all commercial establishments, including all businesses, industries, nursing homes and schools. All such newspapers, magazines and other paper materials shall be placed by the user at a place designated by the City.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
