

ORDINANCE NO. 1173 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF THE ORDINARY EXPENSES OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN IN 1976 UNTIL SUCH TIME AS THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS MEASURE SHALL BE PASSED AND DECLARE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Auditor be authorized to pay all ordinary bills and salaries of the City in 1976.

SECTION 2. That any payment above authorized shall be chargeable to the appropriations in the annual appropriations measure when passed.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

To expedite payment of the ordinary expenses and salaries of the City of Oberlin,

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
